

What is Shopmobility

Shopmobility is a community service that provides mobility scooters to anyone who cannot easily manage to get around the town.



The service provides manual and powered wheelchairs. It can be on a regular or short term basis. Users must be over 14 years of age. We can also provide lightweight "boot scooters" on a longer term basis.

Starting to use the service

Before using this service, we will help customers decide if using a wheelchair or scooter is the best option.



We will give training and a demonstration to ensure new users can use the equipment safely and confidently.

This training is important to ensure that the scooter or wheelchair can meet the individual needs of the customer and that they are able to have full control in a safe and effective manner.

Getting to Us

The Shopmobility Centre is in the multi-storey car park and spaces are allocated near the reception so that scooters can be brought to your car when needed.



Dial-a-Ride

This service is run by the same charity and so links very well to Shopmobility. The driver can easily contact the centre to assist with getting the scooter to the bus.

Collect 'n' Scoot

This is a customer collection service offering transport from your home to Fareham Shopmobility, where your scooter, power chair, etc will be waiting for you.

For one price, this package deal includes travel and equipment hire.



After your hire one of our friendly drivers will take you home and can even help you with your bags.

Membership

We offer annual and day membership. There is a charge for each use. When using the service for the first time members must provide ID Documents with their address on (e.g. recent utility bill or a drivers licence).

Wessex Shopmobility

Fareham Shopmobility membership includes membership of the Wessex Shopmobility scheme.



This enables you to use the facilities of many of the Shopmobility schemes within Hampshire and nearby. You will not have to pay the membership fee, only their daily rate for hire.
